When Chris came up with the idea of identifying music out of thin air, everyone said it was impossible. Then, he embarked on a journey to make it possible through not just one but many innovations (Shazam). He has continued to invent new things and learn from amazing innovators during 8 years at Google, 4 years at Dropbox, and as founder of his new company, Guard.

Chris created Shazam after being told by every "expert" that his outlandish idea was impossible. It was an idea far ahead of its time – eight years before iPhone apps even existed.
